1. In the present petition, grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner has not been granted the benefit of 1st, 2nd and 3rd ACP as per the ACP Scheme dated 28.10.2016 (Annexure P-3) despite the fact that the petitioner had rendered required years of service with the respondent-department.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the benefit of ACP has not been extended to the petitioner by the respondents and that too without any valid justification hence, an appropriate direction needs to be issued to the respondents for the grant of said benefit to the petitioner under the ACP Scheme for which, the petitioner is entitled.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of submitting a representation dated 17.01.2023 (Annexure P/6), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be

satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case the representation dated 17.01.2023 (Annexure P/6) has been received from the petitioner and is still pending consideration with the respondents, the same will be decided by the respondents in accordance with law and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
