This application has been filed for amendment of prayer in Para No.16 of the main petition where details of FIR is inadvertently wrongly typed.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and Registry is directed to make necessary correction.

Main case

The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking anticipatory bail to the petitioner i FIR No.0005 dated 16.01.2024, under Sections 308, 341, 323, 506, 148, 149 of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station City-1, Sangrur (Annexure P-1).



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This Court vide order dated 06.03.2024, while issuing notice of motion, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his joining the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 06.03.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Investigating Officer does not controvert the said fact and further submits that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

In view of the above, the order dated 06.03.2024 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
