1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 10 read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 21.10.2022 passed in CWP-18870-2018.
2. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 21.10.2022 passed in CWP-18870-2018 has been complied with; necessary orders have been passed and even the payment has already been made to the petitioner.
3. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
4. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
