1 Through the instant petition, prayer is made seeking direction from this Court ordering the setting up of CBI headed SIT to investigate the murder case of Prince, son of Malkiat Singh, in which inordinate delay has been caused on the investigation system of Punjab Police, in time bound manner, under a court monitored mechanism.
