1. On 23.04.2024, a co-ordinate bench of this Court had passed the hereinafter extracted order, upon the instant petition:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that the petitioner has been implicated in the aforementioned FIR on the basis of disclosure statement made by Subudeen who has already been granted the concession of regular bail.

List on 29.05.2024.

In the meanwhile, petitioner will join investigation before the Investigating Officer as and when called. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail, till the next date of hearing, on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”

2. A perusal of the last order dated 29.05.2024, reveals that in deference to the aforesaid order, the petitioner failed to join the investigation with the investigating officer, however on request of learned

counsel for the petitioner, petitioner was granted last opportunity to join investigation.

3. Today at the very outset, learned State counsel, on instructions imparted to him by the police official concerned, informs that though the petitioner has joined investigation, however, he has not fully co-operated at all with the investigating officer, as he has not got effected the recovery.

4. Since the petitioner, despite given two effective and adequate opportunities to join the investigation, and to co-operate with the investigating officer, has failed to do so, therefore, he is not entitled for pre-arrest bail.

5. Consequently, the instant petition is **dismissed**.
