1. State counsel has placed on record a copy of communication dated 30.04.2024 received from the office of Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala. Its relevant extract is reproduced as under:

“9. That in compliance to the judgment/decreed dated 28.01.1993 passed by the learned Lower Court as well as direction issued by the Director General of Police, Punjab, Chandigarh vide his office memo No.3115/LA-5 dated 18.05.1998, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala has passed order No.4294-4300/S dated 27.05.1998 with the

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direction the respondent – Constable – Dalbara Singh is entitled to get all the arrears of pay and allowances and as well as increments which was admissible for the period w.e.f. 26.05.1986 till reinstatement along with interest at the rate of Rs.12% per annum subject to the decision of RSA No.276 of 1994 titled as State of Punjab Versus Dalbara Singh, which is pending in the Hon'ble High Court at Chandigarh.

10. That as per position explained in the above said para No.10, Pay and allowances w.e.f. 26.05.1986 to 19.12.1989 (out of Service) Total amount Rs.76,057/-, after deduction G.P. Fund Rs.5,485/-, the remaining amount of Rs.70,572/- vide draft No.582180 dated 30.05.1998, Amount of Interest Rs.43,578/- on the amount of pay and allowances w.e.f. 19.12.1989 to 31.12.1997 vide Bank draft No.582206 dated 02.06.1998. Amount of interest Rs.3,584/- on the delay payment w.e.f. 1.1.1998 to 28.05.1998 vide Bank draft No.582595 dated 19.07.1998 as well as Cost of decree Rs.1025/- vide order No.31387-91/B dated 16.09.1998 have already been paid to the respondent – Constable – Dalbara Singh. So, now no any dues is pending in this office of the respondent – (Constable – Dalbara Singh). This letter has been approved by the Senior Superintendent Police, Patiala.”

2. Upon instructions, State counsel submits that respondent has retired from service on attaining the age of superannuation

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and the appeal has become infructuous.

3. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
