The instant petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C., proffers the hereinafter extracted relief, as craved by the petitioners, inasmuch as, quashing of the FIR No.0088 dated 26.07.2021, under Sections 365, 323, 355, 506 and 149 of IPC, and under Sections 27/54/59 of the Arms Act, and under Section 66(E) of the Information Technology Act, 2000, registered at Police Station Sultanwind, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar, along with all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of a compromise dated 26.06.2021 (Annexure P-4).
2. Since the FIR (supra) has already been quashed by this Court vide order of even date, passed in CRM-M-10094-2024, therefore, the instant petition has become infrutuous.
3. The instant petition is **dismissed** as having been rendered infructuous.
