This is a petition filed under Section 439 read with Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking grant of concession of interim bail to the petitioner for 15 days in FIR No.499, dated 19.11.2022, under Sections 302, 307, 323 read with Section 34 of IPC, 1860 and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Sadar, Sonapat.

In compliance of the previous order, which was passed on 12.03.2024, learned State counsel has apprised the Court, on instructions from ASI Salender, received through report, that father of the petitioner was admitted in Parkash Multi Specialty Hospital, Rohtak since 12.02.2024 being diagnosed with Pulmonary TB and thereafter, has not visited the hospital for further follow up. This Court has gone through the photographs annexed with the present petition and medical record annexed herein (Annexure P-1 to P-3) along with certificate from the aforesaid hospital, which is sufficient to say

that there is father of the petitioner, who needs care and attention of one of the family member and there is no one else to look after his ailing father. Mr. Virk further submits that the petitioner has an elder brother as well to take care of his father but Mr. Sharma had countered the said assertion referring to the medical history of his brother Dinesh Kumar showing follow up and discharge card dated 02.11.2023 and 24.11.2023 (Annexure P-4) PGIMS, Rohtak dated 02.11.2023 suffering from mental and behavioural disorders due to use of alcohol.

In the light of above, this Court would deem it appropriate to grant interim bail to the petitioner for 10 days, who shall be released on 15.03.2024 and shall surrender back to the Jail Authorities on 24.03.2024 at 04.00 PM. He shall be released on interim bail, subject to his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The present petition is disposed of in the above terms.
