1. The aforesaid case was filed on 01.03.2019 by Mr. Jaskaran S. Attar, Advocate. The Registry had raised objection on the case file on 02.03.2019. After that the case was re-filed on 08.05.2019, but the objection raised by the Registry was not removed.
2. As per Rule 9, Chapter 1, Part-A, Volume V, Punjab and Haryana High Court Rules and Orders, the petition on which objections have been raised by the Registry is to be taken back by the counsel/party, who filed it, to be re-filed within a total period of 40 days. The present case was filed on 01.03.2019 and the Registry raised objections on 02.03.2019, but neither the petitioner nor his counsel ever turned up to receive the present case and file the same after removal of the objections as raised by the office.



3. Office has got listed this case as the same alongwith other cases of the same nature is lying in the office as incomplete case and none has worried to take further recourse in the matter. The case has been shown in the urgent cause list and none has appeared for the petitioner, when it is called and taken up.
