1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to release the salary of the petitioner from August 1997 till date and until the salary is paid restrain respondent No.4 from holding the inquiry proceedings against the petitioner or in the alternative transfer the inquiry proceedings to some other competent officer from some other organization.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the disciplinary proceedings against the petitioner has been culminated into passing of the dismissal order dated 08.01.2002 and an appeal filed by the petitioner against the order of dismissal has also been dismissed vide order dated 09.05.2002 which is subject matter of CWP No.18319 of 2004 which was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 06.02.2024

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and consequently, the instant writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
