DEEPAK GUPTA, J.(ORAL)

On 04.03.2024, following order was passed:

“Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.21 dated 02.02.2024 registered under Sections 21B/27-61 of NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Garhi, District Jind.

As per allegations, main accused Geeta was found in possession of 13 grams Heroin. In her disclosure statement, she nominated the petitioner Kajal to be supplier of the contraband for an amount of ₹13,000/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is innocent and has never been involved in any such case; that petitioner is ready to join the investigation; that petitioner is nominated on the basis of disclosure statement which is not admissible.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Parveen Kumar Aggarwal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent- State.

Adjourned to 09.04.2024.

In the meantime, in case of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. However, it is directed that the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when so required by the Investigating Officer. She shall not contact any person associated with the case to dissuade him from the investigation in any manner whatsoever and nor



shall leave the country without prior permission of the Court. She shall further comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Today learned State counsel, submits that petitioner has since joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case order dated 04.03.2024 is hereby made absolute, whereby petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
