HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (ORAL)

1. In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that while competing for the post in pursuance to the advertisement No.3/2023 dated 20.03.2023 (Annexure P-1) the petitioner should have been awarded 46 marks in the written examination, which would be more than the marks secured by the last selected candidate.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the evaluation of OMR sheet of the petitioner has not been done correctly keeping in view the answer key issued by the respondent hence, the respondents are under obligation to re-evaluate the marks awarded to the petitioner so that, the petitioner does not suffer prejudice.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance raised in the present writ petition has already been raised by the petitioner through a representation dated 09.02.2024 (Annexure P-7) and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a time

bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

4. Notice of motion.
5. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.
6. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the representation of the petitioner dated 09.02.2024 (Annexure P-7) has been received in the office and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the concerned authorities within a period of two weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
7. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
8. Ordered accordingly.
