The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.0908 dated 30.09.2023 registered under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 (Haryana Amendment Bill, 2020) at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 05.03.2024, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A status report dated 17.04.2024 by way of an affidavit of Narender Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Samalkha, Panipat has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 05.03.2024 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
