LISA GILL, J.

1. Prayer in this writ petition is for quashing notice dated 06.02.2020 (Annexure P-1) issued under Section 13 (4) of Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (for short 'SARFAESI Act'), by respondent – Bank.
2. Notice of motion was issued in this writ petition on 04.03.2020. It was directed that operation of sale notice dated 06.02.2020 shall remain stayed till next date of hearing subject to petitioner's depositing a sum of Rs.15 lakhs with respondent – Bank on or before 12.03.2020. In case amount is not deposited, interim order would cease to operate.

3. Learned counsel for respondent – Bank today informs that amount in terms of order dated 04.03.2020 was never deposited and that property in question has been successfully auctioned with sale deed being executed.

4. Perusal of paperbook reveals that since November, 2022, none has been appearing on behalf of petitioner. On 19.01.2024 yet again, none appeared on behalf of petitioner despite the matter being called twice. Interim order was thus vacated. Today again there is no representation on behalf of petitioner who, it appears, is not interested in pursuing the matter any longer.

5. Writ petition is, accordingly, dismissed in default and for non-prosecution. In case, any incorrect fact has been placed before us, petitioner is at liberty to file appropriate application within four weeks.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
