Present criminal writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed by the petitioner praying for issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 1 & 2 for protection to his life and liberty at the hands of respondent Nos. 3 & 4.

[2] Upon notice, learned State Counsel has filed a status report by way of affidavit dated 15.04.2024 of Sh. Harsimaran Singh Bal, PPS, DSP (City-II), District SAS Nagar, on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 & 2, which is taken on record. Copy thereof be supplied to the opposite side.

[3] Learned State Counsel submits that earlier a complaint received against the petitioner at the hands of his wife, has now been closed as per report dated 28.12.2023 in pursuance to settlement arrived at between them.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions, also assures the Court that in future if any action is contemplated against the petitioner, all necessary statutory provisions under the provisions of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 including Section 41-A and the ratio of case law titled

“Arnesh Kumar Versus the State of Bihar”, (2014) 8 SCC 273, shall be followed.

[4] In view of the contents of the aforesaid status report as well as assurance given by the learned State Counsel, nothing more survives for adjudication in the matter.

[5] The petition stands **disposed off**.
