1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 17.05.2023 passed in CWP-10660-2023.
2. Short reply way of affidavit of the respondent filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 17.05.2023 passed in CWP-10660-2023 has been complied with and speaking order dated 20.03.2024 (Annexure R-1) has been passed.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if he feels aggrieved of the order dated 20.03.2024 passed by the respondent/concerned authority.
