NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari, for quashing the impugned revisional order dated 21.09.2004 passed under Section 69 of the Punjab Coop. Societies, Act, 1961, against the order dated 18.6.2004 which had already been passed under Section 69 of the Act, reinstating the petitioner as a Secretary in the society and being so the impugned order Annexure P-7 has been passed in a second revision under section 69 of the Act, which is not maintainable.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner has been ordered to be reinstated in service and thereafter, he has retired and therefore, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.



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3. In this view of the matter, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
