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SHEEL NAGU, C.J. (ORAL)

1. This petition has been filed by an aspirant for admission to UG Courses (B.Sc Nursing/BPT/Paramedical Courses) for the Session 2023-2024.
2. Various grounds have been raised in this petition, but learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to satisfy this Court as to why, in the given facts and circumstances of the aforesaid Course having commenced on 01.02.2024, this petition was filed as late as on 01.03.2024.
3. It is settled in law that in matters of education and professional courses, the time-line set for counselling and admission is to be strictly



adhered to. Any delay on the part of the petitioner renders the cause infructuous.

4. The grant of relief in such delayed approach to the Court may lead to unsettling a lot of settled things which ought not to be done especially when the Course has begun.

5. We, therefore, decline to interfere in the matter.

6. The petition, accordingly, stands dismissed.
