Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the official respondents No.2 and 3 to form a special investigating team of higher officials for conducting an impartial and speedy investigation in FIR No.89, dated 15.04.2020, under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City-I, Abohar.

Status report by way of an affidavit of Dr. Pragya Jain, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka, on behalf of respondent No.3-State has been filed and the same is taken on record. Para 14 of the said report is as under:-

“That on 18.04.2024, non bailable warrants of arrest of accused Jaswinder Singh has been got issued from the learned Court of Shri Satish Kumar Sharma, SDJM, Abohar for 25.04.2024”.

Learned State counsel has further assured the Court that investigation will be completed within a period of two weeks positively and

thereafter in the next three weeks after taking due approval, final report as to the outcome of the investigation be presented in the Court.

In view of the above, nothing survives in the instant petition and accordingly the same is disposed of. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to move an application for revival of the petition, in case State of Punjab do not adhere the assurance given before this Court.
