of revision petition (CR-1602-2019), which is listed for 09.05.2024.
Application is duly supported by an affidavit of the applicant-
petitioner.

No objection to the prayer is raised by learned counsel
for respondents.

With the request and consent of learned counsel for
parties, hearing of revision petition is pre-poned from 09.05.2024 to
today itself.

Application is accordingly disposed of.

CR-1602-2019

1. This is a revision against the order dated 02.02.2019 (Annexure P-10) whereby the application of petitioner (defendant/applicant before the learned lower Court) under Order 9 Rule 13 read with Section 151 CPC for additional evidence for placing on record the death certificate of his father (late Saudagar Singh) was dis-allowed.

2. Heard.

3. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner restricts his prayer for placing on record the death certificate of his father (late Saudagar Singh), issued by Chief Registrar (Births and Deaths, Punjab) and does not press for placing on record certified copy of the register of Gurudwara Sri Patalpuri Sahib and Sri Kiratpur Sahib.

4. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that copy of the death certificate is already on record of the lower Court and he be given one opportunity to place the same on record. One copy of death certificate as mentioned above is taken on record with direction to supply one copy of the same to the counsel for non-applicant, during the course of the day.

5. The learned counsel for respondents No.2(a), 2 (b) 2 (c) and 2 (d) on instructions from respondents-non applicant submits that the respondents have no objection to the above limited prayer as made above by the petitioner.

6. In view of above, the revision petition is disposed of in

terms of allowing the petitioner to place on record the death certificate of his father (late Saudagar Singh), issued by Chief Registrar (Births and Deaths, Punjab), in additional evidence before the learned lower Court.

7. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
