The appellant/plaintiff has filed the instant regular second appeal against judgment and decree dated 20.08.1993 passed by learned Additional District Judge, Sirsa, whereby an appeal filed by the respondents/defendants was allowed and judgment and decree dated 11.06.1992 passed by learned Sub Judge Ist Class, Sirsa was set aside.
