1. On the last date of hearing i.e. 05.08.2024, the following order was passed :-

“Prayer in this writ petition filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, for quashing the order dated 08.02.1999 (Annexure P-1) passed by Commissioner, Patiala Division, Patiala.
