1. This is an old appeal which has come up for hearing after a period of 30 years.
2. Respondent late Sh. Jagdish Mittar filed a suit for the grant of decree of permanent injunction restraining the defendants from forcible possession of a plot. He claimed that he is in possession as tenant under defendant no.2-Surjit Singh.
3. On the other hand, it is the case of the defendant No.1(appellant herein) that he has purchased the property from defendant no.2-Surjit Singh, on 10.07.1984.
4. Both the courts held that the plaintiff is in possession as tenant and therefore he cannot be disposed except in due course of law.
5. The learned counsel representing the appellant submits that the respondents have permanently shifted overseas and today the plot is lying vacant. He submits that the appellant being owner has already entered possession. Therefore, he prays for permission to withdraw the present

appeal.

6. Ordered accordingly.
7. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
