VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos. 2 and 3 not to obstruct the stage carriage operation of the petitioner on Raman to Kanakwal via Phullo, Giana, Takhatmal, Kallanwali, Desu Malkana route.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that inspite of the best efforts, office of the counsel for the petitioner has not been able to get in touch with the petitioner and hence, he prays that the present petition may be disposed of at this stage but liberty may be granted to the petitioner to revive the petition in case any cause of action survives.

3. In view of the above facts and circumstances, present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the present case, in case, any cause of action survives in the same.
