DEEPAK GUPTA, J. (ORAL)

The two petitioners are husband and wife. They are in their mid sixties. They pray for their release on regular bail in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.141 dated 02.08.2023 under Sections 302, 450, 341, 506, 427, 326, 323, 324, 201, 148, 149 of the IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot.

2. Learned counsel contends that only role attributed to petitioner No.1 Gurcharan Kaur (referred in FIR as Pammi) is to have raised lalkara. On the other hand, role attributed to petitioner No.2 Angrej Singh @ Ranga is to have given as many as six blows with axe to injured- complainant Basant Singh.

3. On the last date of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioners has prayed for grant of bail to petitioner No.2 Angrej Singh on the ground of his medical condition. However, today as per the report of Department of

Neurology placed on record by learned State counsel, the said patient is being evaluated for urethral structure which can be done on OPD basis and that he will require admission for surgery as and when indicated after evaluation, in which ever institution he wants treatment. As far as investigation is concerned he is not suffering from any urological cancer.

4. In the aforesaid facts and circumstances, petitioner No.2 Angrej Singh is held to be not entitled for grant of bail on the medical condition.

5. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner has made a statement so as to withdraw petition *qua* petitioner No.2- Angrej Singh @ Ranga.

6. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, petition *qua* petitioner No.2- Angrej Singh is hereby dismissed as withdrawn, at this stage.

7. Petitioner No.1- Gurcharan Kaur (referred in FIR as Pammi), who is attributed only to have raised lalkara, is allowed bail as she is in custody since 02.08.2023 i.e. for the last more than 09 months, with no other criminal case pending against her, on her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
