1. The present petition has been filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for wilfully violating the order dated 15.12.2023 passed by this Court in CWP 28183-2023.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Pawan Kumar Longia, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent. He has produced on record a copy of order dated 22.05.2024 passed by the respondent, which is taken on record. The aforesaid order shows that in compliance with the order of the writ Court, necessary seniority list has been finalised and nothing survives in this petition. The Registry is directed to scan copy of the aforesaid order and place the same on the file at an appropriate place.

4. Counsel for the petitioner has not disputed the factual position.
