1. Two connected cases which are pending for the last 30 years has come up for hearing. The appellant in the appeal, who is also respondent in the connected COCP remains unrepresented. He files suit for permanent injunction restraining the defendants from interfering for taking forcible possession of the property.
2. As per the office report, the sole appellant has died and the learned counsel representing the appellant has been informed, however, there is no representation. It appears that with the passage of time, the appellant has lost interest in prosecuting the matter.
3. Both the cases are dismissed for non-prosecution.
