JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of orders dated 27.10.1997 (Annexure P-5), 20.12.1995 (Annexure P-3) and 20.12.1994 (Annexure P-2) whereby petitioner was removed from service.
2. The petitioner joined respondent-CRPF as Constable. The respondent dismissed him from service on the ground that the Board from which he has secured matriculation certificate is not recognized.
3. The matter is pending before this Court for last more than two decades. The petitioner was removed from service on 20.12.1994 i.e. about 30 years back. He worked for a short stint i.e. 6 years which was substantially less than minimum qualifying service for pension.
4. This Court on account of afflux of time and afore-stated facts finds that no substantial relief at this stage can be granted to the petitioner. It is apt to

notice that respondent is disputing claim of the petitioner. Thus, this Court does not find it appropriate to consider the petition on merit.

5. Dismissed.
