1. Competing the claim of the widow mother of Sh. Naveen to receive service benefits on account of death of Sh. Naveen, is pending before the trial Court. Widow of Sh. Naveen filed an application under Order VII Rule 11 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, for rejection of the petition filed by the Sh. Naveen's mother under Section 372 of the Indian Succession Act, 1925, by the mother at the threshold.
2. The trial Court has dismissed the application. As per the provisions of the Indian Succession Act, 1925, the petition for grant of succession certificate is required to be decided in a summary manner.
3. Keeping in view the facts of the case, the trial Court is requested to make sincere endeavor for disposal of the main petition within a period of three months from today, positively.
4. With these observations, the revision petition is disposed of.
5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
