**KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)**

1. Through the instant petition, prayer is made for issuance of appropriate directions upon the official respondents no.1 to 3, to arrest the private respondents no.4 to 8, being accused in case FIR No.109, dated 14.10.2017, under Sections 302, 148, 149 and 506 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Arniwala, District Fazilka.

2. Upon notice of motion issued, various status reports were filed by the respondent-State. In last report dated 17/20.03.2024, filed before this Court, it was stated that after completion of the investigation, earlier a cancellation report was filed before the learned *Illaq*a Magistrate concerned, on dated 16.07.2021, however same was not accepted, and on

dated 19.07.2021, the magistrate concerned return the aforesaid cancellation report, and directed the investigating agency to carry out further investigation.

3. In compliance to the order (*supra*), the investigation was carried out by the senior functionaries of the respondent-State, and now again a cancellation has been recommended on dated 15.03.2024, by the SHO, Police Station Arniwala, as “no unnatural cause of death could be ascertained”, and the same has also been approved and verified by the DSP, Jalalabad.

4. Today, learned State counsel, on instructions imparted to him by ASI Malkeet Singh, informs this Court that even the cancellation report dated 15.03.2024 so prepared, has been presented before the magistrate concerned on dated 23.08.2024.

5. Since the cancellation report in the instant FIR, has already been preferred, which is pending consideration before the magistrate concerned, no further order is required to be passed at this stage. Therefore, the instant petition is ordered be closed.

6. **Disposed of** accordingly.

7. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner that in case he still has any grievance with the cancellation report (*supra*), he can approach the concerned court, by moving an appropriate motion.
