KULDEEP TIWARI, J (ORAL)

1. The main grievance of the petitioner is with regard to registration of FIR No. 126 dated 28.07.2018, under Sections 452, 506 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station City Kotkapura, District Faridkot (Annexure P-6) which led the petitioner to file the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
2. Though other issues have also been raised, however, the main issue which arises from the registration of the above FIR, which according to the petitioner, is a false, and a concocted with ulterior motive.
3. Learned State counsel on instructions imparted to him by ASI Sukhdev Singh, informs this Court that after conducting investigation in the FIR (supra), the cancellation report has been prepared, and same has been filed before the learned Illaqua Magistrate concerned.
4. Considering the above statement, this Court finds that no further action is required in the instant petition, as the main grievance regarding registration of the

FIR (supra) has already been redressed as a cancellation report before the learned Illaqua Magistrate is already filed, which is pending consideration.

5. So far as the second issue is concerned, the petitioner has liberty to file an appropriate complaint, by making an appropriate motion before an appropriate Court / Forum.
6. In view of the above, the instant petition is disposed of accordingly.
