VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned order (Annexure P-4 to P-6) vide which the allotment of the house No. 3664, Sector 22, Chandigarh has been cancelled.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the petitioner has vacated the premises and has handed over the vacation report, a copy of which has been taken on record as Mark-A, and has submitted that the present petition, in all probability, has been rendered infructuous.

3. None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said aspect.

4. In view of the above facts and circumstances, present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the present case, in case, any cause of action survives in the same.
