SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (Oral)

1. The present applicant-petitioner is availing the facility of parole but the term of parole is to end today itself. However, the applicant-petitioner has placed on record a prescription slip, whereby he has been diagnosed to suffer from Hepatitis C.
2. Consequently, the counsel for the applicant-petitioner submits that the period of parole thus to end today be ordered to be extended.
3. Initially, this Court has no jurisdiction to extend the period of parole, as the said jurisdiction is to be exercised by the competent authority. However, the only exception to the above is comprised in substantive material becoming placed on record, thus suggestive that

the applicant-petitioner is bed ridden, therefore, he is unable to step into the prison concerned rather on expiry of the parole term.

4. The prescription slip (supra), does not suggest, that the present applicant is bed ridden nor thereby the exception (supra) to the apt jurisdiction to extend the parole period vests at this stage in this Court.

5. Consequently, finding no merit in the instant petition, the same is dismissed and the present applicant petitioner is directed to surrender into the prison concerned.

6. However, as a special case to enable the present applicant-petitioner to arrange for his medication, for his ailment becoming treated. Therefore, he is permitted to step into the prison concerned in the afternoon of 8th March, 2024.
