1. By way of present writ petition filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has approached this Court for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to decide the appeal, Annexure P12 filed by him under the provisions of the Punjab Cooperative Societies Act, 1961 challenging the letter dated 20.04.2023, Annexure P11.

2. Advance copy of the petition has been served upon respondents. Upon instructions received from Mr.Rohit Gupta, Joint Registrar, Cooperative Societies, U.T., Chandigarh, learned Additional Standing Counsel, U.T., Chandigarh requests that as the competent

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officer has been assigned election duties, the appeal will be decided within a period of four months. His request is accepted.

3. Petition is disposed of. Respondent No.2 - Joint Registrar, Cooperative Societies, U.T., Chandigarh is directed to decide the appeal after hearing the parties within a period of four months from the date of communication of a copy of this order.
