1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to the respondents to grant him promotion as Technical Grade-II w.e.f. 01.01.1998. The petitioner is further seeking direction to the respondents to relax conditions of eligibility for the purpose of promotion.
2. As per office report, notice was sent to counsel for the parties.
3. On 12.10.2022, the following order was passed:-

“There is no representation on behalf of the parties today.

In the interest of justice adjourned to 08.05.2023.

However, no adjournment shall be granted.

Let the intimation regarding the next date of hearing be given the counsel for the parties.
