This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent no.3 i.e, Inquiry Officer i.e, Sub Divisional Officer, Sub Division Malikpur, Upper Bari Doab Canals (UBDC), Pathankot to adjudicate and decide the application dated 08.02.2024 (Annexure P-14).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the application dated 08.02.2024 (Annexure P-14) is not properly worded and thus, seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after giving full and better particulars.
3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
- 4, It is made clear that in case any such petition is filed, the same would be considered independently, in accordance with law.
