GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. Petitioners-Vedpal @ Pandey, Sukhdeep, Ajit Yadav, Vikram Singh, Surender Singh @ Chiku, Surender, Surender Chaudhary have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.660, dated 03.10.2021, Police Station City Narnaul, District Mahendergarh, under Sections 120-B, 148, 149, 365, 387 of IPC and 25 of Arms Act 54 of 1959, and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 07.03.2024, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

3. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Narnaul, has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statement of petitioners/accused Vedpal @ Pandey, Sukhdeep, Ajit Yadav, Vikram Singh, Surender Singh @ Chiku, Surender, Surender Chaudhary and complainant/victim Ballu Saini have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.
4. Complainant/victim Ballu Saini in his statement had stated that he has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
5. The learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Narnaul, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.
6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.660, dated 03.10.2021, Police Station City Narnaul, District Mahendergarh, under Sections 120-B, 148, 149, 365, 387 of IPC and 25 of Arms Act 54 of 1959 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
