1. Instant petition under Section 482 Cr. PC has been preferred seeking directions to respondents No. 1 to 2 to transfer the inquiry/investigation in case FIR (Annexure P-1) to any other District in the State of Punjab except Fatehgarh Sahib. Details of the FIR are as under: -

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner had moved a representation dated 02.02.2024 (Annexure P-5) to Additional Director General of Police,

Rupnagar Range, Rupnagar, to transfer the inquiry in the aforesaid FIR to any District out of Fatehgarh Sahib but due to inadvertence, the inquiry has been entrusted to Fatehgarh Sahib by the authorities concerned by overlooking the request made by the petitioner that he has sought transfer of the inquiry out of Fategarh Sahib district.

3. After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the instant petition with liberty to file the fresh representation before the Additional Director General of Police, Rupnagar Range, Rupnagar for redressal of his grievance in accordance with the law.

4. Disposed of as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
