1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to the respondents to consider case of her grandson for appointment on compassionate ground.
2. Mr. Aman Dhir, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, at the outset, submits that the petitioner had made a representation dated 18.07.2023 (Annexure P-5) claiming appointment for her grandson on compassionate ground. The said representation stands rejected vide order dated 09.02.2024 passed by Director General of Police, Punjab. The petitioner has not assailed the said order.
3. Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has not received the aforesaid order, thus, she may be granted liberty to avail remedy as permissible by law against the said order.
4. Disposed of with aforesaid liberty.
