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**DEEPAK GUPTA, J.(ORAL)**

On the previous date of hearing, the following order was  
passed:

*“By way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.,  
petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.20 dated  
15.02.2024 registered under Sections 365, 382, 427, 34 IPC at Police  
Station Nangal District Rupnagar.*

*The alleged occurrence took place on 14.02.2024 at about 08:30  
PM, when car of the complainant Rajinder Kumar was allegedly hit by the  
car being driven by co-accused Kartik, in which petitioner was sitting. That  
two persons alighted from the car of the complainant and forced the  
petitioner to sit in his car and took him away.*

*Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it was a simple case  
of accident, and to make it more serious, Section 365 IPC has been added.  
Learned counsel further contends that both the parties reside in the same  
locality and that the petitioner is ready to join the investigation. None of the  
party was caused any injury.*

*Notice of motion.*

*Mr. Sahil R. Bakshi, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the  
respondent- State. Copy of the petition be supplied to him during course of  
the day.*

*Adjourned to 18.04.2024 for filing status report.*

*In the meantime, in case of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/ Investigating Officer. However, it is further directed that the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when so required by the Investigating Officer. He shall not contact any person associated with the case to dissuade him from the investigation in any manner whatsoever and nor shall leave the country without prior permission of the Court. He shall further comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”*

As per the status report filed today, the petitioner has not joined the investigation till date. Apart from this, after registration of the present case, petitioner has been involved in yet another case bearing FIR No. 35 dated 02.04.2024 under Sections 307, 323, 506, 120-B and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Nangal and, thus, he has misused the concession of interim bail granted by this Court.

In view of the aforesaid report as submitted by learned State counsel, the present petition is hereby dismissed.
