Prayer in the present petition is for quashing the order dated 01.02.2024 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.3. Further prayer has been made for directing respondents No.1 to 4 not to remove the petitioner from the office of Sarpanch, Gram Panchayat, Siroli, District Nuh. Further prayer has been made for directing respondent No.2 to grant interim stay/protection to the petitioner against removal from the office of the Sarpanch during the pendency of her appeal before him.

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner has, *inter alia*, contended that the appeal filed by the petitioner is pending adjudication before the learned Commissioner which is fixed for 20.03.2024. He has submitted that along with the appeal, petitioner has also filed stay application however, the same has not been decided and learned Commissioner has summoned the record for 20.03.2024.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Upasana Dhawan, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State. She has submitted that the stay application has already been heard as is apparent from perusal of the order

dated 21.02.2024.

Heard. On hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, it is apparent that the appeal filed by the petitioner is pending adjudication however, learned Commissioner has summoned the record for 20.03.2024. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of. However, if no final order has been passed by the Commissioner on the stay application filed by the petitioner, the same be heard on the adjourned date i.e. 20.03.2024 and on hearing both the parties, the same be decided in accordance with law and thereafter the main appeal be also decided expeditiously.
