1. Instant writ petition has been filed by the petitioners in the nature of Mandamus seeking direction to the respondents not to dispossess the petitioners from the land in dispute.

2. On 15.07.2024, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners seeks an accommodation to prepare and argue the matter.

At his request, adjourned to 22.10.2024.

It is made clear that no further adjournment shall be granted.”
