The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing respondent No.2 to recover the minor detenue namely Tamana (daughter of Rakesh Kumar) and to produce her before this Court and praying for permitting the petitioner to meet the detenue Tamana and also to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondent.

After arguing for some time, having failed to make out the case for grant of writ in the nature of habeas corpus since the alleged detenue is stated to be missing from 18.11.2023 and in that regard, an FIR has already been registered bearing FIR No.129 dated 21.11.2023, which is under investigation but no effective result have been made out so far by the investigating agency, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition

Prayer is accepted.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to take recourse of other remedies in accordance with law for any grievance left out.
