1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, seeking a writ in the nature of *Certiorari* for setting aside the impugned order dated 18.11.1998 (Annexure P-6) passed by learned Financial Commissioner, Haryana, impugned order dated 23.02.1996 (Annexure P-5) passed by learned Commissioner, Gurgaon Division, impugned order dated 29.06.1995 (Annexure P-4) passed by learned Collector, Mahendergarh and impugned order dated 26.10.1994 (Annexure P-2), passed by learned Assistant Collector Ist Grade, Mahendergarh.

2. On 12.07.2024, the following order was passed:
