After arguing for considerable time, keeping in view the fact that the promotion order in respect of private respondent No. 6, whereby he was promoted to the post of Joint Director, Agriculture, has been passed during the pendency of the present appeal on 06.03.2024, learned counsel for the appellant does not press the present appeal with liberty to file a fresh writ petition on the same cause of action to challenge the said promotion order. Apparently, even apart from merits, the writ petition was dismissed on the ground of being pre-mature by the learned Single Judge.

Learned counsel for the respondents have no objection to such course.

Accordingly, the appeal is disposed of with the aforesaid liberty.

All the pending miscellaneous applications also stand disposed of.
