Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned orders dated 31.01.2022, 06.09.2021 and 28.01.2020 (Annexure P-8, Annexure P-5 and Annexure P-4), passed by learned Divisional Commissioner, Division Rohtak, District Jhajjar, learned Collector, Beri District Jhajjar (respondents No. 1 and 2) and Assistant Collector, 2nd Grade, Beri, District Jhajjar, respectively.
