1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to take appropriate action on the complaint dated 19.02.2024 and to trace out the brother of the petitioner expeditiously.

2. Learned counsel submits that despite representation/complaint made to the official respondents to come to her rescue as the private respondents had been continuously threatening her with dire consequences, no action had been taken by them. In support, she has drawn the attention of this Court to Annexure P-7. She submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions could be issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to look into her representation dated 19.02.2024 (Annexure P-7) and take appropriate steps at the earliest.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Amit Rana, Sr. DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

5. In view of the restricted prayer made by learned counsel

for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to look into the representation dated 19.02.2024 (Annexure P-7) and take appropriate steps expeditiously, if any, required, in accordance with law.
