1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned orders (Annexure P-11 and P-13).
2. Learned State counsel has submitted that the present matter pertains to year 1999 and the petitioner has already retired from service and thus, the present petition, in all probability, has been rendered infructuous.
3. As per report of the registry, counsel for the petitioner has been informed but none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said aspect.
4. In view of the above facts and circumstances, present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the present case, in case, any cause of action survives in the same.
