JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside or order dated 18.03.1998 (Annexure P-5) whereby Government has declined to refer claim of the petitioner to Industrial Tribunal.
2. During the pendency of the petition, the matter was referred to Daily Lok Adalat.
3. From the perusal of record, it comes out that there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner before the Daily Lok Adalat.
4. Even today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. It appears that with the afflux of time, the petitioner has lost his interest to pursue the matter.
5. The Central Government has refused to refer claim of the petitioner to Labour Court. If the impugned order is set-aside, at the most matter would be referred to Labour Court. A period of more than two decades from the date of

impugned order has passed away. At this stage, it would not be just and fair to refer the matter to Industrial Tribunal.

6. Dismissed.
