1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the present petition, claim of the petitioner is that he is entitled for arrears of salary as well as grade pay w.e.f 01.01.2006 till 30.06.2013, which benefit has not been granted to him by the respondents and that too without any valid justification hence, the respondents may kindly be directed to release the said benefit to the petitioner forthwith along with interest.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of submitting a representation dated 21.12.2023 (Annexure P/7), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and submits that in case representation dated 21.12.2023 (Annexure P/7) has been received from the petitioner and is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
